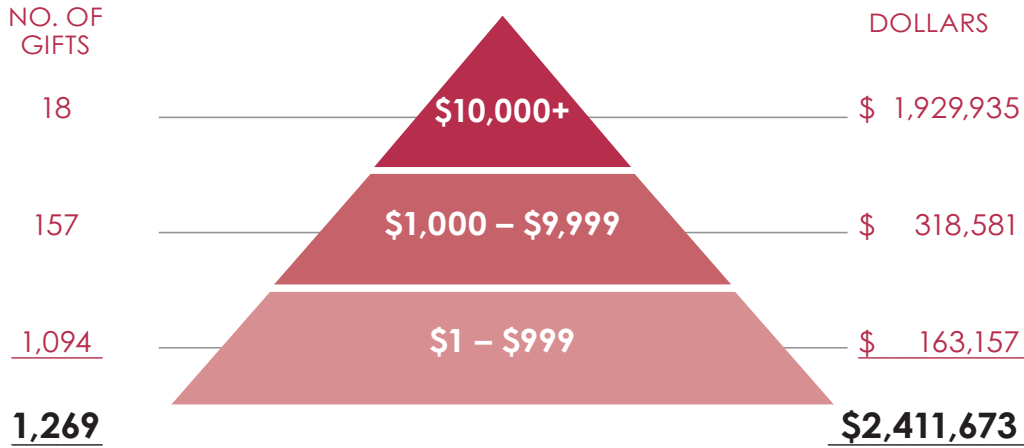

Making the impossible **POSSIBLE...**

When Janee Weber called the NWC Foundation office in December of 2016, she was looking for former college employee Steve Sims.

She wanted to thank him for throwing a lifeline to her more than 40 years ago; her debt to him had been on her mind. Janee was sad to learn that Steve Sims had passed away more than 15 years ago and she had missed the opportunity to thank him personally.

However, during the phone call Janee learned she could add to Steve's legacy of supporting students by donating to the Steve Sims Memorial Leadership Scholarship Endowment. Donating to NWC in Steve's name changed Janee's life once again; she went from NWC student beneficiary to NWC alumni benefactor. Since that December phone call, Weber has returned to campus for a walk down memory lane and in March of 2017 she shared her "rags to riches" story with the NWC Women's Giving Circle.

Flashback to the August day in 1973 when Steve Sims stepped in to change Janee's life. It was the

first day of class at Northwest College, and Janee was hoping to become the first person in her family to attend college. She'd come to NWC on a whim, after learning that a family friend who had always wanted her to attend college had been killed in a car accident. She knew there was an Equine program at NWC so with \$300 in her pocket, she walked into the Admissions Office. "I'd like to go to college," she told the woman at the

desk. "Have you applied?" the receptionist asked.

It hadn't occurred to Janee that one simply couldn't show up to sign up, and it was beginning to look like she was going to be sent back home when a man who was leaning against the doorway to his office listening came to her rescue, "Young lady, why don't you come into my office and sit down for a minute." That man was Steve Sims, who worked in

NWC's admissions office from 1973-86 and later served as Dean of Students until 1998. By the end of the day, thanks to his care and support, Janee had secured two work-study jobs, she was enrolled in classes, and her room, board and tuition had been paid with scholarship assistance. She still had \$1 in her pocket.

Janee went on to graduate from NWC with her associate's degree after succeeding not only in the classroom but also as an NWC athlete. She was recruited to the women's basketball team her first year and went on to play both volleyball AND basketball for Northwest College as a sophomore. She was a member of the first women's basketball regional championship team.

While attending Northwest College, Janee also joined the livestock judging team and competed at the Denver Stock Show. Her various travels took her to many amazing places, and her eyes were opened to new possibilities. When an opportunity came to study in England, she worked hard and borrowed so that she could go abroad. These experiences expanded her thinking and helped her realize her potential.

"It wasn't until this time of my life, when somebody asked me to tell my story, that I was struck by what Steve had done for me, Weber noted. "How the staff must have chuckled and shook their heads about this rangy Montana gal who just showed up with \$300 in her pocket. I so wish I could have thanked him properly for taking a shot and helping someone so clueless. Thank you NWC for hiring a man who made the impossible possible."

Northwest College plays a crucial role in the professional and personal success of countless students. And Sims' investment in Janee paid off. Today, Weber owns three businesses, a ranch in Columbus, MT, and three-quarters of a city block in downtown Billings. Along with her professional accomplishments, she takes pride in mentoring young people (including individuals in the Montana prison system) whenever she gets the chance.

Much has changed on campus since Janee's time here in the mid-70s, but it's still the personal attention from caring faculty and staff that often makes the biggest difference in our students' lives.

Involvement and investment

All donations to the Foundation matter, but it can be hard for individuals to imagine how one \$100 gift (in this instance the annual membership fee for the NWC Women's Giving Circle) can make a difference. Yet small gifts, pooled together, can do great things!

When 60 donors joined hands in giving during 2016, the cumulative effect was enough to seed an endowment with \$5,000+ and award a \$1,000 scholarship to one deserving young woman.

In one year's time, the Giving Circle's passion for and appreciation of the college has grown along with its membership as participants learned by experience the quality instruction being received by NWC students. First, members experienced the beauty and intrigue in the constellations at a stargazing night lead by NWC Astronomy and Mythology faculty and volunteers. Next they tried on the life of a law enforcement professional, practicing their shooting skills in the firearms simulator and visiting with Criminal Justice program graduates (both women) about life as a Park County jail security guard and a Bridger, MT, Police officer.

The NWC Women's Giving Circle will continue learning by experiencing during 2017. Art and English faculty John Giarrizzo and Burt Bradley (recently retired) will lead a nature hike in mid-July, demonstrating how to use journals with outdoor adventures. This

will be a short version of the class the two of them have been teaching for years, "Drawing and Writing in the Wild." Later in the year, Aura Newlin, Anthropology faculty, will lead a Refugee Camp Simulation or teach a Peruvian Pan Pipe lesson.

The NWC Women's Giving Circle Scholarship Endowment will help students like Janee Weber — featured in the accompanying story — who would not have been able to enroll at NWC in 1973 without scholarship funding. The awards target applicants with lower academic performance and demonstrated financial need who need a helping hand in order to realize their potential. Giving Circle members have also begun conversations about adding a mentoring program for NWC female students.

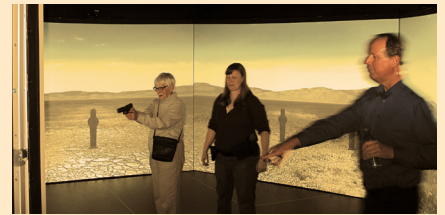

A legendary... LEADER

Educated in math and science, SinClair Orendorff moved through the professional educational ranks at various institutions until he was hired as president of Northwest Community College in January of 1967.

Among many accomplishments during his tenure at NWC, SinClair considered his most significant to be: Securing the college's financial viability and stability through an expansion of the college's funding district; attaining full accreditation for NWCC with the North Central Association of Colleges and Universities; an increase in faculty size and quality along with a significant increase in students; expansion of the curriculum to include technical and vocational education as well as a general education requirement for all associate degrees; the construction of the NWCC campus' Carillon in appreciation of his parents lifetime dedication to education; and helping to form the Wyoming Association of Community Colleges and the Wyoming Community College Commission as he worked with the Wyoming Legislature. He remained at NWCC until his retirement in June of 1988.

His 21 years of leadership are unparalleled, as is the legacy he leaves at Northwest. SinClair passed away on September 27, 2016.
